Responsible to:

Site Manager

Aims:

A vital team that provides 24-hour security and safety throughout the event, working on a shift rota.

Stewards help set-up and take-down the events. Some physical fitness is required, as well as a sense of humour and enjoyment in relating to young people.

Responsibilities:

To protect the safety of delegates:

- Fire safety – ensure clear exits from venues.
- Venue safety – notify Site Manager of safety hazards. Ensure the capacity of venues is not exceeded.
- Evacuation – follow the instructions of the Site Manager
- Crowd management
- Encourage safe behaviour
- Remove rubbish from venues.

To check registrations (name badges) at entry to venues.

Assist Production Team and Site Manager with set-up and pack-down of the event. (Lift safely at all times – training will be given.)

Conditions:

To complete Team leader registration procedures, including police check and references

Must be on-site from 10am January 2nd until pack-down is complete on January 7th.
