

Village Hosts

Responsible to:

Village Host Team Leader

Aims:

The village set up is a crucial part to running a Soul Survivor festival. The principle behind the Village system is to divide the site into smaller areas so that the delegates can be cared for more easily. Delegates can also be located more easily on site and have the opportunity to form friendships with other youth from nearby youth ministries. Village hosts will work with three group leaders in each village to provide a ratio of approx 1:10 leaders to delegates.

Responsibilities:

Village layout – with implications on health and safety, access for emergency vehicles etc.

Delegate welfare – an initial point of contact to delegates and to refer to other teams as necessary.

Practical support – assist with putting up tents, cooking, shopping or other tasks.

Communicate daily notices to delegates.

Enforce the site rules – especially keeping an eye out for alcohol and drugs.

Security – watching out for non-delegate campers etc.

Assistance in emergency situations e.g. finding missing persons, illness or injury.

Ensure that delegates follow procedures for leaving the site during the festival.

Ensure the admin team are notified of any changes to delegate allocation within villages e.g. if they move to another village or leave the festival early.

Meet daily with group leaders in your village to identify delegate needs or concerns.

Communicate daily with the Village Host team leader.

Notify the Site Manager of any health or safety concerns and follow the instructions of the Site manager in an emergency situation e.g. evacuation.

To provide a gas BBQ for your village (with a full gas cylinder!).

Concessions:

Free Registration. You must provide your own tent and food (apart from breakfast, which will be provided for you in the Leaders lounge, where you can interact with the speakers and other youth leaders).

Conditions:

Booking:

Reference:

The referee you nominate on your application must not be related to you in any way. If the minister of your church is a relation, please use another leader from your church and specify their job role.

Application Procedure:

Once we have received your application we will be contacting your minister or Church leader for a reference. We will also be police-checking all applications. We will notify you as soon as possible to inform you as to whether your application has been successful. Once you have been accepted onto the team we will send you a letter confirming this and detailing other important information.
